Community Education and communication

Our Consultants have provided quality education programs to local people in a variety of formats which cater for the illiterate. These include various literatures, activities, training programs, and practical workshops. These education programs have been designed, written and implemented by Urge consultants. Training manuals are written in Melanesian Pidgin English and use local examples and context to enhance the learning experience. - Population data collection, demographics and village profiles

Project implementation and logistics in a rural environment

Urge Consultants have practical experience in implementing various community development projects in rural areas of Papua New Guinea. Project experience is primarily in the area of sustainable livelihood projects which include:

- Alternative protein farming (rabbits, chickens and fish)
- Water and Sanitation projects (water tanks and VIP toilets)
- Improved agriculture (crop rotation gardening, rice milling)

Due to the remote location of the projects in Papua New Guinea, the logistics in implementing such projects has been difficult, in particular the transportation of materials. However with 10 years experience working in both East Sepik and Sandaun Provinces. Our consultants are equipped with the necessary networks and knowledge to implement both small and large scale projects. Success in this area includes:

- Established 320 x 1000 gallon Tuffa Tanks and water catchment systems to 42 villages
- Established 40+ rabbit farms throughout the project area (Torricelli Mountain Range)
- Delivered materials for establishing chicken coups 42 villages
- Delivered fish fingerlings throughout the project area
- Rice milling machines being used by groups of villages
- Delivery of seeds and gardening training in 18 villages

Capacity Building for local grassroots people in PNG

- Facilitation of various education programs and participatory learning experiences including PHAST / CLTS, HIV/AIDS and family planning training
- Improvements in local staff and stakeholder attitudes

Scientific research and biodiversity assessment
